Important guidelines for Examinations

1. There will Be Two Term Examinations in a year – TERM-I & TERM-II. There will be an examination at the end of each semester, Moreover, there will be Internal assessments in every semester- **PA-I & PA-II**.
2. Students must pass in the aggregate for each subject. For promotion to the next grade at Harmony School a minimum of 33 per cent marks in each subject is a must. This applies to every student from grade one on.
3. Students absent from an examination, for any reason, are not re-examined.
4. Those absent from a test because of illness must produce a medical certificate and submit within a week.
5. For sufficient reasons, such as unsatisfactory progress in studies, insufficient attendance, serious misconduct, etc. a pupil may be debarred from an examination.
6. No boy/girl without a minimum of 75% attendance will be allowed to appear for the final examination.
